

- Verify there is only 1 year checked
- Under "Configure" click Test Connection






Download Descriptors


- Data and Reporting Data Exchange
- Descriptors (State Codes) Run Now
- Total Descriptors should be between 3000 and 3300
- Issues if descriptors are in the 1000's or 8000's



Code Set Mappings

- System Management Data Exchange
 Code Set Mappings
- Look through each "Code Set" every year
- This year's "gotcha" Staff
 Classifications and Deprecated Values







Pushing Data - Run All or Run

Details Publish Data Processing Dependencies Publishing Errors Data Exceptions Published Last Published Run All

- When to use Run All vs Run
- You always start with "Publish All"
- Clear up any Dependencies or Errors before moving to next section
- Common reasons for errors
- When do you contact PS support??



- On Demand Data needs to be Published once and then Scheduled
- You can now do "Run All" here
- Best to "Run All" and "Publish All" as soon as possible at the start of the year



Scheduling On Demand

- Recommendations for Scheduling
 - Choose "Publish Changes"
 - Attendance Schedule Daily
 - Student Grades Schedule Daily
 - Student Transcripts Schedule Monthly





Start with PowerSchool Are all the dependencies and errors cleared up?

- If you need help with errors or dependencies Contact PowerSchool Support
- All data has been transferred
 - Role Validation Report is wrong
 - Check your Code Set Mappings Staff Classification
 - Special Group Counts wrong on At A Glance
 - Make sure students are marked correctly in PS
