

#### A few obstacles in Michigan....Circa 2013




- Proliferation of data systems including Student Information Systems

- Major gaps in skill sets leading to inequity in data utilization










- ➤ API Integrations Ability to generate a key/secret and provide connection details to upstream and downstream systems.
- Inbound Integrations Ability to load data from flat files. These are largely manually created for important data sets like assessments, discipline data, etc.
- Outbound Integrations Ability to export flat files in formats needed by downstream systems.
